## Location Description:

The Stone Ranch is situated roughly 8 miles west of Eden and about 30 miles east of San Angelo, accessed via a short easement on Highway 87 in Concho County, Texas.

## Terrain:

The ranch features rolling live oak territory and is renowned for its abundant live oak trees, with minimal cedar and mesquite. It has been well-maintained over the years, with extensive control of mesquite and cedar across most of the property.

## Water:

The ranch is well-supplied with water for both livestock and domestic use. There is one water well that, when drilled in the 1960s, produced 20 to 30 GPM. A new single-horse pump now operates on the well, producing 10 GPM. A large storage tank near the houses supplies water to all pastures. The water well also provides for the residents.

## Improvements:

### Main House:

The main house underwent a complete remodel and expansion in the 1980s. This well-maintained 4-bedroom, 3-bath home is shaded by large live oaks and features a spacious back porch perfect for watching sunsets on the ranch.

### Guest House:

Located adjacent to the main house, this small, one-bedroom, one-bath home features a charming front porch.

### Foreman's Home:

This is a single-wide manufactured home that has been kept in good condition.

### Barn:

The large barn serves as a versatile space and is in excellent condition, currently used for storage.

- The ranch is divided into three pastures and two traps, with one of the pastures featuring an attached field.



### Recreation:

The ranch offers good recreational opportunities, including hunting and livestock raising. The game includes dove, a large population of turkeys, white-tail deer, varmints, and numerous Axis deer roaming the area.

### Minerals:

Some minerals are negotiable.

### Comments:

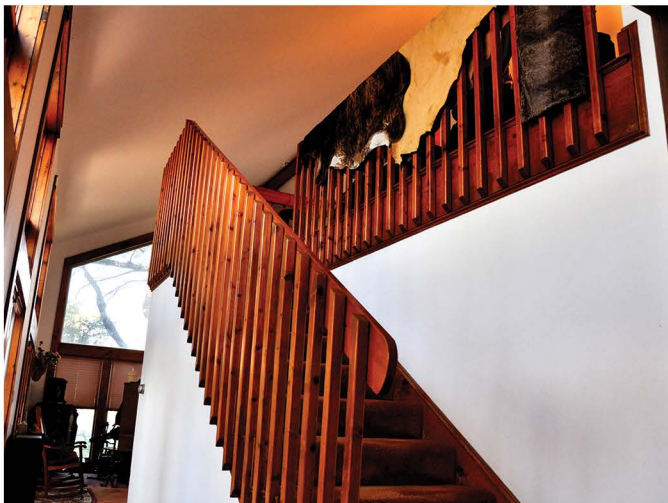
This is an exceptional ranch that has remained in the same family for generations. A property of this quality with such a large number of live oaks rarely becomes available in this area. Come see it before it's gone.

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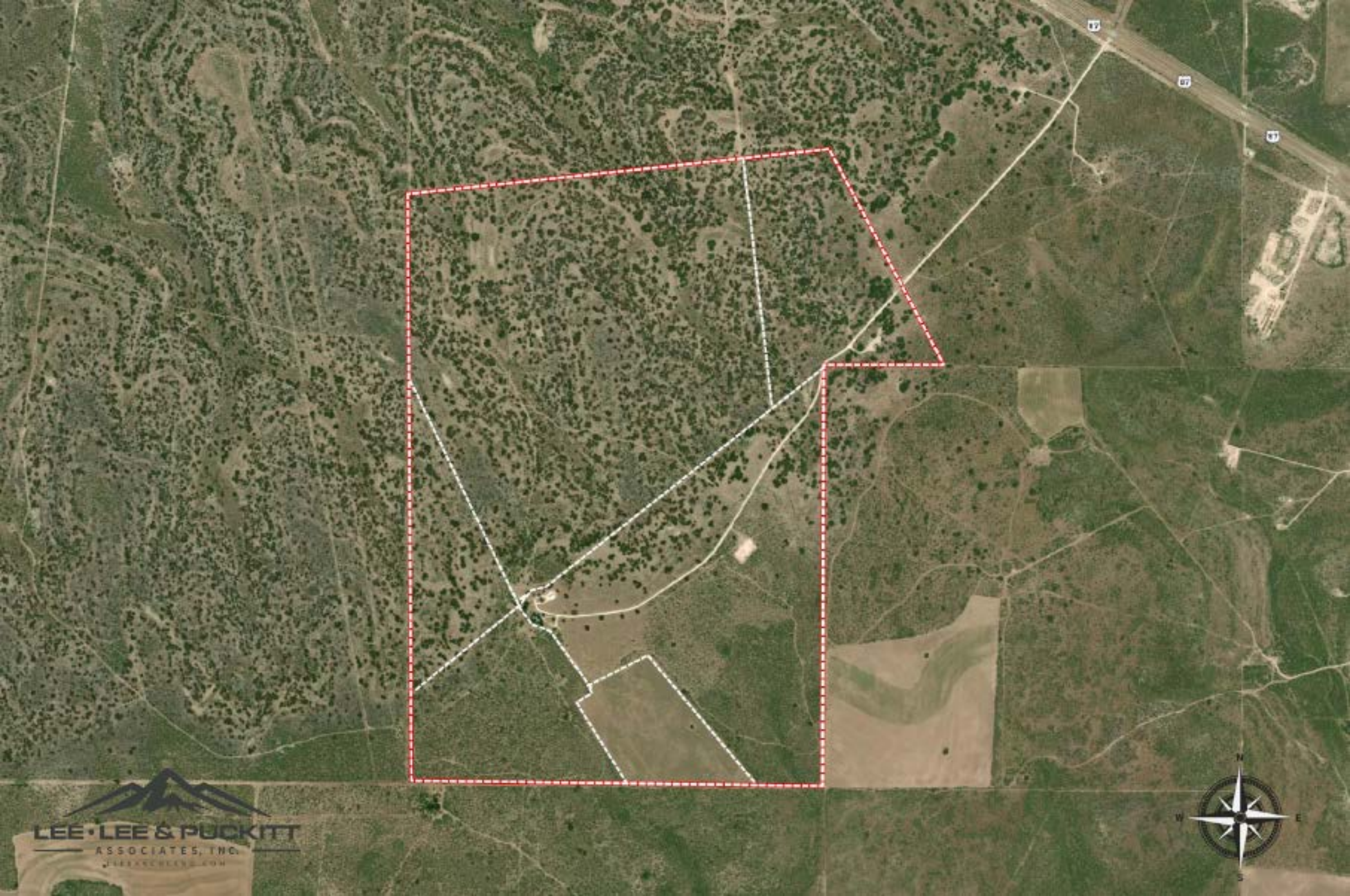
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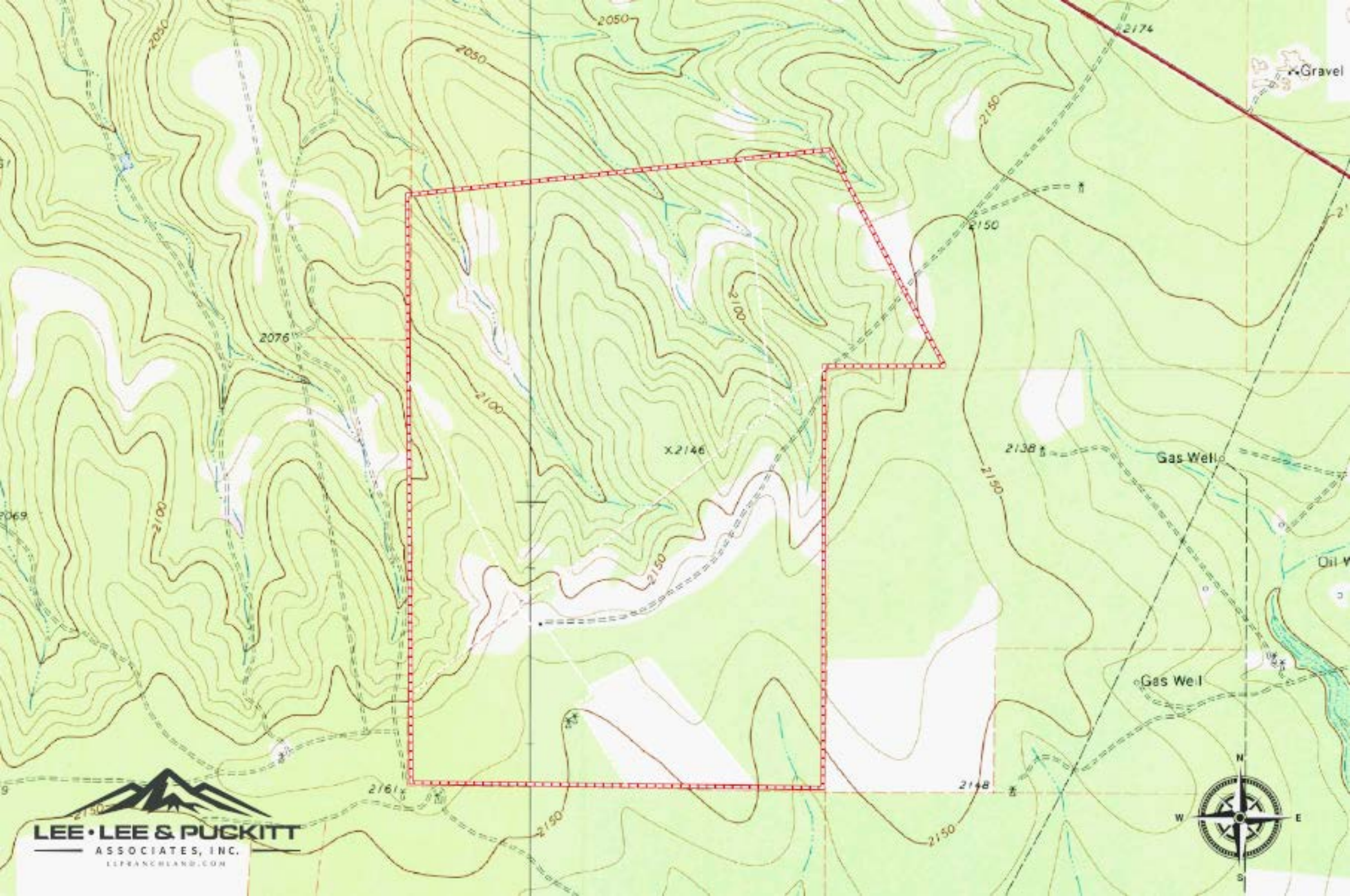
